The book constitutes a significant contribution to the expert debate on Turkish domestic politics. The conclusions drawn offer avenues for further research—both within this specific domain and in terms of their application to other regions or as a subject of comparative analysis.

The book is clearly and systematically structured, providing both a foundational context for the topic and an in-depth analytical examination. It unequivocally demonstrates the author's ability to conduct rigorous scientific research and to produce high-quality academic writing. Prior to publication, the book underwent a thorough peer-review process before. There is obviously not so much space for the current reviewer to find any significant errors and issues. Reviewer's questions for the habilitation thesis defence

The book was published in 2022. The dynamics of developments in Turkey and the broader Middle Eastern region is high. I assume that the author continues to monitor the issue. Have there been any significant or noteworthy shifts in the past two years regarding Islamist and Kurdish parties in Turkey? How are these parties responding to Turkey's increasingly assertive foreign policy, which is often characterized as neo-Ottomanism?
